The Day of the Lord

Satan bound: no longer permitted to deceive the nations

"We must work the works of him who sent me while it is day; night is coming, when no one can work. As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world."
John 9:4-5

Satan released: only for a little while to deceive the nations and then destroyed
(Rev 17:11-14; 2 Thess 2:1-12; Ezekiel 38 and 39)

- Jesus promises to be with us to the very end
- Jesus gives us full assurance and guarantees that no harm will come to us when our faith is in Him
- Jesus has equipped us with everything we need to do His Father's will
- Jesus has sent the Holy Spirit to convict the world
- Jesus is in charge - there is no authority above Him and nothing happens apart from Him or outside of Him
- Jesus has blessed us with every blessing - He has withheld nothing from us
- Jesus has sent us to proclaim Him and make disciples
- Jesus wins - nothing will stand in the way of His work

- You have nothing to lose because you have been given everything and no one can take it from you
- You have been sent to proclaim the only good news there is. All other news is hopeless and lifeless
- You lack nothing to do what God is commanding you to do
- You are never alone because Jesus is always with you
